Bloodborne Pathogens Training:

Time: 1 hour

This course will teach participants how to protect themselves and others from exposure to bloodborne pathogens on the job, and what to do if an exposure occurs. This course was designed to assist employers with meeting the training mandate as stipulated in the federal OSHA Bloodborne Pathogens Standard. Certifications are good for one year.

Adult and Pediatric First Aid/CPR/AED:

Time: 5.25 hours

Certifies patrons who pass written test and skills test to recognize and respond appropriately to cardiac, breathing, and first aid emergencies for adults and children. Certifications valid for two years.

Water Safety Seminar:

Time: 1 hour

This seminar was created by TAC staff and discusses the importance of water safety and awareness. Drowning is the leading cause of death for children in the Triangle Area and TAC is dedicated to educating you about water safety and the programs our community has available to them.

Adult CPR:

Time: 2.2 hours

Certifies patrons who pass the written tests and skills test to recognize and respond appropriately to cardiac emergencies for adults. Certifications valid for two years.

*Participants who pass this are not certified to use an AED

Adult AED:

Time: 1 hour

Certifies patrons who pass the written tests and skills test to use an AED on adults. Certifications valid for two years.

*Participants in AED-only courses must have current Red Cross or equivalent certification in CPR

Adult CPR/AED:

Time: 2.75 hours

Certifies patrons who pass the written tests and skills test to recognize and respond appropriately to cardiac emergencies and use an AED for adults. Certifications valid for two years.

Adult First Aid/CPR/AED:

Time: 5 hours

Certifies patrons who pass the written tests and skills test to recognize and respond appropriately to cardiac, breathing, and first aid emergencies for adults.

Certifications valid for two years.

Pediatric CPR:

Time: 2.5 hours

Certifies patrons who pass the written tests and skills test to use an AED on children and infants. Certifications valid for two years.

*Participants in AED-only courses must have current Red Cross or equivalent certification in CPR

Pediatric CPR/AED:

Time: 3.1 hours

Certifies patrons who pass the written tests and skills test to recognize and respond appropriately to cardiac emergencies and use an AED for children and infants. Certifications valid for two years.

Pediatric First Aid/CPR/AED

Time: 5.25 hours

Certifies patrons who pass the written tests and skills test to recognize and respond appropriately to cardiac, breathing, and first aid emergencies for children and infants. Certifications valid for two years.

Infant CPR:

Time: 2.25 hours

Certifies patrons who pass the written tests and skills test to use an AED on infants. Certifications valid for two years.

*Participants in AED-only courses must have current Red Cross or equivalent certification in CPR
