Triangle Aquatic Center COVID-19 Protocol

Updated 2/3/2021

- 1. A patron who tests positive for COVID-19 <u>must do all of the following</u>:
 - a. Notify TAC by email to ebowie@triangleaquatics.org so that contact tracing and facility sanitation can begin.
 - b. <u>Isolate</u>** until <u>10 days have passed</u> since the date of the positive test <u>or</u> the date of the onset of symptoms.
 - c. Have no **symptoms** for the last **24 hours**.
 - d. Receive **written medical clearance** to return to the pool from a licensed medical provider.
- 2. A patron who has any <u>symptoms</u> which could be attributed to COVID-19 must remain away from TAC until the patron receives written medical clearance to return to the pool from a licensed medical provider.
- 3. A patron who has <u>close contact</u> (less than <u>6 feet away</u> for a <u>cumulative total</u> of 15 minutes or more over a 24 hour period) with:
 - a. a person who has tested positive for COVID-19 who has <u>symptoms</u> (and patron's contact with that person was within the period 2 days before that person developed symptoms and through the end of that person's isolation) <u>or</u>
 - b. a person who has tested positive for COVID-19 **but who has no symptoms** (and patron's contact with that person was within the period 2 days before that person's test and through the end of that person's isolation)

must do all of the following:

- a. Notify TAC by email to ebowie@triangleaquatics.org so that contact tracing can begin.
- b. Get tested for COVID-19 (no sooner than <u>5 days</u> after <u>close contact</u>) and notify TAC of the result by email to <u>ebowie@triangleaquatics.org.</u>
- c. Quarantine** for 10 days after last exposure to that person.

^{**} The requirement to isolate and quarantine means that the patron has no "close contact" with friends, TAC patrons, family members, and others.
