

Torpedoes Summer League FAQ's

Q: What is the Torpedoes Summer

A: The Torpedoes is a competitive swim team in a fun environment! Experienced coaches will work with your swimmers and help them reach their goals, whether they are technique based or competition based. This is one of the most fun competitive swimming environments, where competition isn't the main focus!

Q: Where do they practice?

A: Torpedoes practice in the first lanes of the Program Pool

Q: How do I register my swimmer for the team?

A: Stop by our Front Desk! Our Front Desk staff will be able to register your swimmer and give them a key tag they need to access the Facility.

Q: How much does it cost to join?

A: \$50 per swimmer after a Torpedoes Summer Pass has been purchased!

Q: Are there any pre-requisites?

A: Swimmers must be able to confidently swim a 25 yard lap of Freestyle and be three years of age or older.

Q: Will my child swim in every meet?

A: Yes!

Q: Does my child have to swim in every meet?

A: No, if you're out of town or are unable to come to a swim meet, there is no penalty.

Q: What happens if my child can't come to a practice

A: No worries! You're able to come to practices based on your family's schedule. Swimmers are required to come to at least two practices a week in order to qualify for a main event race.

Q: When are the swim meets?

A: Tuesday evenings, either at TAC or a local neighborhood pool. Plan to arrive by 4:30pm for home meets, and 5:00pm for away meets.

Q: Are parents required to be at swim meets?

A: Parents are not required to be at swim meets, but encouraged! Parents are also required to volunteer for several swim meets.

Q: What volunteer positions are there?

A: Stroke and Turn judge, Starter, Timers, Ribbon Writers, Runner, and a few more! No Summer League swim team can exist without the help of awesome parents like you!

Q: Does my swimmer have to attend every practice?

A: Nope! You're able to come to the practices that best fit your schedule. But remember, the more practice your swimmer gets, the easier their goals are to achieve!

Q: Who coaches the Torpedoes?

A: The Torpedoes is coached by returning Head Coach Lauren and returning Assistant Coach Jessie. We'll also be welcoming two more coaches this season!
